### CAR AND TRAILER PARKING ARRANGEMENTS

The area around the River Tees Water Centre (RTWC) has developed again which has necessitated a change in the parking arrangements. Access to the site can now be made via Dugdale Street (as previously) or straight from the main gyratory at the west end of North Shore Road. In addition to our own car park we have access to a tarmac car park accessed from Dugdale Street, once this site is full additional car parking space will be used in the trailer park to the west of the centre. Parking of trailers and disabled visitors will again be available in RTWC car park.

Please note there will be NO parking available on the roads surrounding the RTWC as the road is fully open to traffic and double yellow lines are in place.

## Trailers, Cars with boats, Competitors and Spectators arriving by Car - Map 1

Trailers and cars with boats can park in either RTWC Car Park or on the land to the west of RTWC.

Alternatively there are 4 free car parks at the Barrage on the south side of the river. These are accessed from Navigation Way (TS17 6QA) which loops around and under the bridge crossing the barrage. Again it is a short walk (1000m) along the footpath and across the Infinity Bridge to bring you to the north side and the RTWC.

## Parking at RTWC (TS18 2NL) - Map 2

The RTWC car park with be reserved for Trailers and a limited amount of disabled parking. The two main car/trailer parks are a tarmac area off Dugdale Street and the waste land to the west of the RTWC, both can be accessed from North Shore Road which is now accessible directly from the A1046 or via Dugdale Street. The ground to the west of the centre will primarily be for trailers but will also be used as an overflow for passenger vehicles. Personnel will be located in the RTWC car park to assist with the moving of trailers.

There will be parking available for disabled drivers in the RTWC car park.

### **Emergency Vehicles**

At all times please park in a way that will allow Emergency Vehicles access to the Centre and the waterfront, allow other local users access (beyond RTWC) and to enable vehicles and trailers to leave during the day.

### Valuables

Please note that if you leave valuables in your cars and minibuses, make sure that they are out of sight. There are a limited number of lockers in the changing rooms at RTWC which require a £1 coin which is returned after use. Tees Rowing Club cannot accept liability for any loss associated with these parking arrangements.
