The Diploma in Sporting Excellence (DiSE), formally the Advanced Apprenticeship in Sporting Excellence is a two year programme that provides a unique sporting qualification designed to meet the needs of young athletes who have the realistic potential to achieve excellence in their sport and are seeking to perform at the highest level.

At the end of the programme, students graduate with a Diploma in Sporting Excellence, a L3 qualification which carries UCAS points.

The new Diploma starts in October 2018 and Loretta Williams is currently recruiting rowers for new this new award. We have up to 40 places allocated and 33 new learners have already been identified.
