### ***Rowing Leader Award***

Award delivered at Cambois RC over two weekends. Seven juniors attended from four different clubs and all were successful at completing the course. Two courses are scheduled to take place. ### ***UKAD Seminar***

A UKAD Seminar will be taking place on Wednesday the 26<sup>th</sup> of April at Durham School and Durham University. It has primarily been requested by the School and University independently but it will be advertised for the region with some places available if anyone is interested. ### **Coach Mentoring Scheme**

A proposal will be submitted to the committee before the next meeting regarding a proposed coach-mentoring scheme. A similar scheme has been in its initial stages in the Eastern Region with the idea that the Northern Region takes on a similar project. A lot of coaches has already approached me for support and this will hopefully be a way of supporting coaches on a more formal basis.

### **Coaching Survey**

The NCC is now working with BR to role out a coaching survey. This could be independent or part of a larger British Rowing Survey. Depending on time scale a regional questionnaire may be sent out in the mean time.

### **Coaching Needs Analysis**

Following on from the above. I will be individually be contacting all clubs to discuss coaching needs and all areas of coach education requirement. This should be completed by the next meeting and should enable me to target clubs and areas of education requirement.
