

NRC Para Rowing report: March 2018

Gateshead RC are in the process of building a fixed seat double scull boat with children from the Cedars school in Gateshead, the children have learning disabilities and also taking part in indoor rowing sessions once a week at the club, and hope to be having water sessions soon. Volunteers will be required for this to happen and if anyone is interested they can contact Gateshead RC directly.

Gateshead RC are also going to hold a learning disability regatta in approx. July 2018 on either Killingworth Lake or on the small lake at Saltwell park.

At Tees RC former athlete Ella Abrahams (LTA athlete coached by Greg Beswick) who was with the club for 18 months prior to relocating due to work commitments has been placed on the GO Development scheme and is looking at undergoing international classification/

Tees RC are also looking for further athletes to join the squad and who would like to race as there are currently spaces within the club.

It is hoped that Para events will take place at regional regattas should there be enough interest from adaptive athletes from the region/wider country.
