Coach Education Report

- Coach Educator Update Meeting – meeting took place a few weeks ago to discuss future plans and the impact the changes within BR would have on the delivery of coach education delivery in the North East.
- Coach Education delivery timetable for 2018 and 2019 is being finalized and will hopefully published in the next two weeks
- UKCC Level 2 has taken place at Tees RC in October with 12 individuals completing the course with assessments now pending.
- UKCC Level 3 has taken place at Durham University with several coaches from the North East in attendance.
- Coaching Mentoring Scheme is in its early stages of development on the river wear across the colleges and clubs, more information to follow.
- Volunteer hour logging and recognition. Using a Nationally recognized qualification body we are looking at with Durham University how individuals who volunteer are able to log hours and gain official recognition for the amount of work they complete – More information to follow.
- We are looking at developing our own workshop program that will be able to delivered using experts in the region. For example rigging and planning a training program etc.
